- I. Phenomenon of parent-infant attachment
- J. Medical term for "soft spot" on the baby's head
- K. The process whereby the cervix gradually opens to allow the baby to come out of the uterus
- L. Name for the top of the uterus; area that is massaged after delivery
- M. The machine which records maternal uterine contractions and fetal heart rate
- N. Name for a face-up presentation of the baby's head
- O. The area of skin and muscle between the vaginal outlet and the rectum.
- P. Designation of the active phase of first stage labor
- Q. Pelvic floor exercises; and popular name for the muscles in the pelvic floor
- R. Designation of the position of the baby's head within the maternal pelvis.
- S. That phase of first stage labor when labor changes to expulsion; usually the hardest but shortest phase of labor
- T. The organ that nourishes the infant during the months gestation; also called the "afterbirth"
